

## Technical specifications hull&deck Kit Walkabout 39

---

These are the components and services included with the purchase of the kit:

- Composite Hull and deck composite (sandwich e-glass multiaxial fabrics, high density PVC laminated and glued with epoxy resin under vacuum) all finished with gelcoat. The hull and the deck are welded with external lamination and glued with epoxy structural adhesive. The external welding has to be grouted and finished with gelcoat. On the deck have to be made cuts for the portholes and hatches, and have to apply the non-slip paint.
- Composite structural bulkheads and floor (sandwich e-glass multiaxial fabrics, PVC high-density core laminated and glued with epoxy resin) laminated with epoxy to the hull and deck
- Turret for accommodate life raft, welded to the floor of the cockpit (welding have to be grouted and finished with gelcoat)
- Carbon chain plates (2 on the side for high and low shrouds and staysail).
- 2 structural water tanks in composite, capacity about 160 l each.
- 2 plastic water intake installed.
- Lamination of the sail drive saddle (supplied by the customer) and realization of the opening cut for engine sail drive.
- 2 complete rudders with shaft in AISI 630 (is a high resistance stainless steel, also known as 17-4 PH) including Jeffa self-aligning bushings, connecting rods, heads for tillers. The rudders have to be painted.
- Keel ready to be mounted after grouting and painting
- Bowsprit with bow roller integrated glass, specifically designed for anchor Vulcan 20Kg or 20Kg Delta (optional carbon). The hardware and pulleys are NOT included. The pulpit must be adapted to the hull and should be made the holes for fixing and installing the windlass and hardware.
- Side Plexiglas deckhouse windows to be mounted
- 5 Frames lockers (1 forward sail locker, 2 cockpit, 2 side seats) integrated into the deck + its doors. The doors are to be trimmed and the hardware is NOT included.
- Frame for sliding hatch integrated into deck + hatch with plexiglass window, to be trimmed (hardware NOT included)
- Shower and toilet base (only for the bathroom as layout Walkabout 39 No. 1) to be trimmed, placed and glued.
- 1 Closed hatches garage, to be trimmed.
- Detailed project for plywood interior; we will supply DXF files (AutoCAD) for CNC plywood cutting.
  - Phone and e-mail support during the all the time of mounting.
  - 1 visit to the construction site (excluding travel expenses)
- Royalty due to Architect David Reard designer of Walkabout 39, for the building of a complete boat.

To facilitate the completion and construction of the boat has the following kits:

- **Electrical system:** project, pre-wired cables, control panel, power panel, lights, switches etc
- **Water system:** project, autoclaves, quick-connect hoses with taps and fittings, tank levels, faucets, outdoor shower, etc..
- **WC and black water:** Project + Lavac WC + seacocks + Vetus black water tank and components (pipes, fittings, pumps, level indicator etc)
- **Gray water system and bilge pumps:** Project + bilge pumps + sink drain pumps for shower, bathroom and kitchen, pipes, hulls, fittings, clamps, etc ..
- **Engine:** Project, engine installation and diesel supply, diesel tank made in thick polyethylene 350l shaped like the hull bottom, muffler, exhaust pipes, fittings, Racor pre-filter, clamps, tank level, fire extinguisher, remote locking, etc
- **Interior:** Project, supply of components (marine plywood cut by numerical control machine, floor, kitchen and bathroom sinks, oven, refrigerator box hinges, fasteners, mast interior support, etc..)
- **Cushions:** Interior cushions for sofa and chart table seats + bunks mattresses
- **Deck equipment:** Project and supply of all decks equipment components (pulpits, windlass, bowsprit hardware, gunwale teak, stanchions, guardrails, cleats, handrails, footrests, cockpit table, lockers hinges doors, portholes, etc)
- **Sail Equipment:** Project and supply of blocks, winches, stoppers, etc, with all ropes
- **Safety:** Everything you need to meet safety standards over 50 miles (1 raft 8 places ISO 9650 + Epirb + Fires + 8 inflatable life belts + life line + medicine chest + horn, etc)
- **Anchoring:** Vulcan anchor 20 kg + 50 m HR AQUA7 chain, 50 m 16mm anchor rope + 8 fenders with rope + 4 16mm mooring lines 15m long + 1 boat hook
- **Mast:** supply of a complete mast (aluminum or carbon) with boom, rigging, turnbuckle, and running rigging in textiles.
- **Sails:** Supply of mainsail, genoa, staysail and furling gennaker
- **RollBar:** composite rollbar bolted to the transom, eye bolts, brackets for mounting solar panels, spotlight.
